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Servant Reality Follow-up Project Purpose Statement

The purpose of the Servant Reality Follow-up Project is to catalyze a movement of Wesleyan students who are committed to embrace the reality of servanthood as they pursue kingdom-advancing service in both vocational and lifestyle ministry settings.

Crossing the Line Declaration

Consumed: I affirm that my life has its *greatest meaning* in relationship with Jesus Christ...I want to be *consumed* by His love.

Consumed: Heb. 12:28-29--Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, let us be thankful, and so worship God acceptably with reverence and awe, for our God is a **consuming** fire.

Called: I affirm that my life has its *greatest fulfillment* in embracing God's call to personal holiness and kingdom service...I want to live a life worthy of His *calling*.

Called: 1 Pet. 1:13-16--Therefore, prepare your minds for action; be self-controlled, set your hope fully on the grace to be given you when Jesus Christ is revealed. As obedient children, do not conform to the evil desires you had when you lived in ignorance. But just as he who **called** you is holy, so be holy in all you do; for it is written: "Be holy, because I am holy."

Convinced: I affirm that my life makes its *greatest contribution* to God's kingdom when I use my giftedness in the power of His Spirit...I am *convinced* I can make a difference in my world.

Convinced: Rom. 8:38--For I am **convinced** that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height or depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Because I am consumed by His love, called for His purpose and convinced my life will count for eternity, I choose to "cross the line."

Key Result Indicators & Objectives

Gate Keeper Buy-in

Objective: Cultivate an understanding and appropriate ownership of SRFP with key general officials, district superintendents, key pastors and youth pastors/workers

Crossing the Line commitments

Objective: Challenge students to make a commitment to the “Cross The Line” affirmation at the C3 Event

SRFP Registrations

Objective: Motivate students who “Cross The Line” to enroll and participate in the two-year follow-up process

SRFP Small Groups Formed

Objective: Bring students together in church-based small groups (or Sunday School classes) that form after C3 as the first part of the follow-up process

SRFP District/Regional Events Held

Objective: Hold district and Regional events that bring together individuals who have “Crossed The Line” for additional assessment and training

SRFP Service Projects Completed

Objective: Motivate and equip Districts to facilitate student led projects that practically demonstrate the servant reality commitment in action

Servant Reality Follow-up Project – Goals

Crossing the Line Commitments

3,000 students, or approximately 50% of C3 Attendance, based on projected attendance goals of 6,000 students.

SRFP Registrations

2,250 students, or approximately 75% of those who make the Crossing the Line commitment, of which, 50% or 1125 will continue on in the process over the following 2 years.

SRFP Small Groups Formed

150 small groups, with an average of 8 students per group, or a total of approximately 1,125 total students who continue on in the process over the 2 years. (Online Bible study for those churches who do not provide a small group for them.)

SRFP District & Regional Events

25 District events, averaging 45. (based on 1,125 students and 25 District events) 6 – 8 Regional events in 2 years, averaging 150 per event.

SRFP Service Projects

40 Service Projects that involve 1,125 students, averaging 28 students per project.
